While we were not ready for a chapel renovation at that point in time, we liked the idea and found that it would be in the best interest of Mariapolis Luminosa. After discerning together, we arrived at selecting a crucifix that seemed appropriate. On Sunday, June 13 a mass was celebrated in the chapel followed by a blessing of the new crucifix. We thank Fr. Evariste, Fr. Kohlmann and Fr. Rider for celebrating this special mass with us. We look forward to when you all can return to visit us in Luminosa and see our new crucifix.









Luminosa Conference Center (LCC)

The Luminosa Conference Center staff continues to prepare the way for more groups to return to Luminosa. Recent upgrades have taken place in the bedrooms with new bedspreads, in Adsum with a new storage section for chairs and a coffee station, in Belcher Hall with newly painted walls and a coffee station and improvements in the houses with more amenities.



Dining Hall freezer-refrigerator

Last December we discovered that, for reasons unknown, the flooring beneath the kitchen walk-in freezer had rotted away. After consulting with various companies and experts, we arrived at the conclusion that the freezer-refrigerator unit needs to be removed and the floor replaced. Since it is advisable to not reinstall the current freezer-refrigerator due to the unavoidable breaking of the seals when removed, a new freezer-refrigerator unit will need to be purchased and installed. The task of supporting the floor and bracing the walls has been completed. Next is to assess the cost of this work and begin with removing the unit.

Youth One Stop

Mariapolis Luminosa, through the LCC, has partnered with *Youth One Stop*, a comprehensive education and job-training program within The Chamber Foundation in Dutchess County.

Youth One Stop is a program utilizing local resources to benefit at-risk youth in the county. The program is open to income-eligible youth, ages 14-24 who are facing obstacles inhibiting them from completing school, finishing their HSE or gaining employment. This program is in cooperation with the Dutchess County Workforce Investment Board. In our partnership, the youth who are part of the program, along with their adult chaperones, come to Luminosa to perform volunteer service work. Their first day was June 9 which began with orientation which offered a mini lesson on safety in the workplace followed by an introduction to Mariapolis Luminosa. Their schedule will bring them to Luminosa throughout the summer.





General Counsel and local changes

This year's general counsel, which took place in January, was the moment the Focolare worldwide came together to review the past 6 years and plan for the next 6. During the process, the thousands of suggestions and reflections that came in from Focolare members around the world provided a great opportunity of collective discernment on which future paths to take. Soon after, a guiding document was shared called "Courage to Embrace the World".

As the counsel looked at the upcoming 6 years, it seemed clear that it was time for some changes in some parts of the world. A few of those changes are happening close to home. Here at Luminosa this summer **Julie Moon** will be moving to the Focolare house in Montreal.

Julie arrived in the summer of 2018 beginning the adventure of being co-director of Luminosa with Mike Morse on a team with Donna and Sid Hayden. In August, after 3 years she will move to Montreal to be co-director of the Central East Canada region with Attilio Polsoni.
